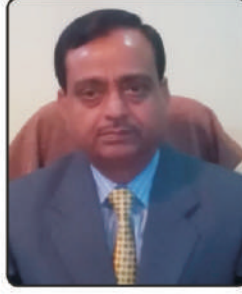

## Editorial....

Meanwhile a new and unforeseen problem emerged from Wuhan of China and casted the whole of Europe, USA, middle and south Asian regions including India. The pandemic named Covid 19 is caused by Novel Corona Virus of unknown origin. This is being suspected by rest of the world that COVID 19 is a laboratory developed virus that does not respond to any of existing medicines. **Mr. Donald Trump, the president of USA, nick named it "Chinese Virus" and accused China for using the virus as a biological weapon against USA and other European countries.** Spain, Italy, France, Britain, Turkey and Brazil are the worst effected countries besides USA where over 200 thousands of people had already lost their lives on account of this pandemic. Fortunately, India declared complete lockdown in the early stage of virus spread and thus managed to keep the number under check of both infections and deaths. **Clearly, India beat America and other European countries on this count by using lockdown as a weapon against community spread of virus infection and saved thousands of citizen lives. But long closure of all business and manufacturing activities has also put India in a big economic and financial trouble. GDP growth of India is likely to remain almost zero if not negative. Income of the**



people is sure to get a hard hit by economic upsets.

Due to Covid 19 pandemic the world economy including that of India has reached in the state of destitute. Long lasted lockdowns and continuance of pandemic leading the world towards bleak chances of economic recovery. The pandemic has created mass unemployment the world over with no sign of hope of regeneration in the near future. The working population is in deep trouble.
